**SWALLOW SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY**

PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

All children with disabilities for whom the Swallow School District is responsible are provided a free appropriate public education as defined by state and federal statutes. Special education services are provided to all children with disabilities from age three through the end of the school term in which they are in eighth grade. The school term is the time beginning with the first day of the school year and ending with the last day that school is in operation for attendance of pupils in that school year.

A written Individualized Education Program (IEP) shall be developed for each child determined to be disabled. The IEP will be developed by the individualized education program “team” and the IEP will be reviewed at least once each year.
